**1:00pm - *At Middleton*** (In theaters January 2014)

Andy Garcia and Vera Farmiga star in this film about a man and a woman who fall in love while taking their kids on a college admissions tour.

**4:00pm - *Nebraska*** (In theaters November 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2013)

After receiving a sweepstakes letter in the mail, a cantankerous father (Bruce Dern) thinks he's struck it rich, and wrangles his son (Will Forte) into taking a road trip to claim the fortune. Directed by Oscar-winner Alexander Payne and shot in black and white across four states, *Nebraska* tells the stories of family life in the heartland of America.

**11:00am -- *My Father and the Man in Black*** (Playing in select theaters and available on video-on-demand, iTunes and DVD)

An intense personal adventure that happens to feature one of 20th-century music's greatest icons, this documentary tells the inside story of 'bad boy' Johnny Cash; his talented but troubled manager, Saul Holiff; and a son searching for his father in the shadow of a legend.

**2:00pm - *Muhammad Ali's Greatest Fight*** (Debuts on HBO on October 5, 2013)

When Muhammad Ali was drafted into the Vietnam War at the height of his boxing career, his claim to conscientious objector status on religious grounds led to a legal battle that landed in the U.S. Supreme Court. The film explores the story behind the court's decision at a time of social and cultural transformation in America. Starring Christopher Plummer, Frank Langella, Ed Begley, Jr., Fritz Weaver, Harris Yulin, Peter Gerety, Barry Levinson, John Bedford Lloyd and Danny Glover.
